Pharmacy First Caps for Sept 2026	Pharmacy Income		Pharmacy First: Updated Pharmacy First caps come into force for Sept 2026. Action: If not already done so, check the NHSBSA website to see what your Pharmacy First cap is for this month.	
Flu (Adult):	Pharmacy Income	01st Sept 2026	Flu (Adult): Pregnant women only, can start to be vaccinated under the 2026/27 Flu Vaccination Service (other eligible patients cannot be vaccinated until 1st October 2026).	
PQS	Pharmacy Income	01st Sept 2026	Aspiration payment is paid to pharmacy owners.	
Pharmacy Enhanced Practice Pathway Pilot for Newly Qualified	Optional	01st Sept 2026	Prescribing: Applications open for cohort one of the Pharmacist Enhanced Practice Pathway pilot programme.	
HCFS	Contractual Requirement	03rd Sept 2026	HCFS: The changes to the Hypertension Case-Finding Service (published in the updated service specification on 6th August 2026) come into effect.	
Men B	Pharmacy Income	30th Sept 2026	Deadline for pharmacy owners to have administered at least 10 vaccines (between 20th July and 30th September 2026) or NHS England may suspend supply of vaccine.	
Terms of Service – NHS Profile Manager	Contractual Requirement	30th Sept 2026	Deadline for meeting the requirement to ensure pharmacy owners have verified and, where necessary, updated the information contained in their NHS website profile and their DoS profile for 1st July to 30th September 2026 quarter of the financial year. This is a mandatory requirement for all pharmacy owners. Action: If you have not updated your NHS website profile and your DoS profile using NHS Profile Manager , complete this by the end of the day.	

PQS	Pharmacy Income	27th August 2026 to 31st Dec 2026	The Palliative and End of Life Care questionnaire (PEoLC) will be published on the NHSBSA website . Pharmacy owners must complete this by the end of 31st December 2026. Since this is a requirement of the gateway criterion, if this deadline is missed, pharmacy owners will not be able to make a PQS declaration.	
Pharmacy First Service Thresholds		Ongoing	Check a week before the end of the month on your Provider Pays IT System that you have met/will meet thresholds for Pharmacy First Service Payment. Encourage Pharmacy Teams to recruit appropriate patients into the service.	
NHS Mail		Ongoing	Ensure all Pharmacy Team members have access to NHS Mail. NHSmail 2 Portal - Home	
Smartcards		Ongoing	Ensure all Pharmacy Team members have working and up to date smartcards. Email: scwcsu.smartcards@nhs.net Tel: 0300 5610429	
Pharmacy IT Systems (PharmOutcomes, etc)		Ongoing	Ensure all Pharmacy Team members have access to Pharmacy IT Systems to ensure consistency with services provided.
